



2014 Companhia Das Lezirias Sauvignon Blanc "Tyto Alba"

A Sauvignon Blanc Medium Dry White Table wine from Tejo, Portugal

The 2014 Sauvignon Blanc "Tyto Alba" is unoaked and comes in with residual sugar of 10.2 grams per liter. Despite the high residual sugar, this seems fruity and well balanced by acidity on opening more than sweet, but, yes, there is a bit of a sweet tinge on the finish. It is very tasty, but also, happily, rather invigorating. Gripping on the finish and very typically Sauvignon Blanc on the nose, this is a beautifully constructed white that has that good acidity to go with reasonable depth. It will be great for warm days. Not very complicated, admittedly, it still does everything well in its crowd-pleasing style. There were 700 cases produced.
